ORDINANCE NO. 876-2024

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING AND SUPPLEMENTING CHATER 14 (WATER AND SEWER) OF THE AVALON BOROUGH CODE PERTAINING TO IRRIGATION AND WATER EMERGENCIES

Section 1 This ordinance amends Chapter 14 (Water & Sewer) of the Borough Code to change and implement new regulations for irrigation at all times and even in the absence of a Declaration of a Water Emergency. The regulations are as follows:

- 1) All properties on which the last digit of the house number is an odd number may irrigate on odd-numbered calendar days beginning no earlier than April 1 of each year and ending no later than November 15 of each year.
- 2) All properties on which the last digit of the house number is an even number, or a "0", may irrigate on even-numbered calendar days beginning no earlier than April 2 of each year and ending no later than November 16 of each year.
- 3) All irrigation shall take place between the hours of Midnight and 9:00 am daily.
- 4) Irrigation is restricted to a maximum of 30 minutes per day,
- 5) Flower boxes may be watered everyday April through November.
- 6) Newly installed lawns and / or landscape beds may be irrigated as needed for the first 21 days following installation. After 21 days, the irrigation schedule set forth in this section shall apply.

<u>Sections 2 & 3:</u> Provides that all inconsistent ordinances are repealed and that the provisions of this Ordinance are severable.

Section 4: Provides that this Ordinance shall take effect immediately.

This Ordinance was introduced and passed on first reading on March 13, 2024 and will be further considered for second reading, public hearing and final adoption on April 10, 2024 at the Municipal Building, 3100 Dune Drive, Avalon, NJ 08202 at 4:00 pm.
