She indicated her understanding is that it is her responsibility to maintain the branches overhanging on her property.

Stephen D. Barse, Esquire, Borough Solicitor commented that that is a zoning issue.

<u>Lisa Grant</u> pointed out that because they are grandfathered it will be her responsibility to keep up the trimming. She questioned whether the owners could be required to do the maintenance rather than her.

<u>Stephen D. Barse, Esquire</u> responded that this is not easy to answer. He will talk to the Zoning Official about this issue.

<u>Lisa Grant</u> reiterated that this is a wonderful step moving forward but it doesn't help with home owners who have to maintain what neighbors have already done.
