Over the years, rapid growth in Avalon and the surrounding communities has caused the existing Peermont Substation (Located between Ocean and Dune Drives from 60<sup>th</sup> and 61<sup>st</sup> Streets) to approach near capacity levels. Rebuilding the existing substation will give us the needed capacity to meet future demands for electricity and will allow us to continue to provide safe and reliable services to all customers for the foreseeable future. This project is one of many that Atlantic City Electric is working on to improve future overall reliability in South Jersey.

Presently, we are in the design phase of this reliability improvement project and we will be reviewing our plans with the municipal officials and the public throughout this process.
