Public Comments:

Martha Wright, 632 7th Street, discussed transparency in government and advocated for the livestreaming of Council Meetings. She expressed that the public should be made aware of the homeowner warranty issue, however the website does not have any updates or information regarding this issue. She noted the Department of Community Affairs had previously advised the Borough that it was not required to notify affected homeowners of their warranty inadequacies. She further noted the sanctions issued against the Construction Official were for homes built by Artisan Fine Homes, although there are still homes built by Avalon Development Group without proper warranties that were not addressed in that action. She expressed interest in the status of the situation and where tax dollars are going throughout this matter, and expected expenditures in the future. She suggested using the money to help affected property owners obtain the proper warranty, and to livestream Council meetings, rather than those funds being used for an appeal of the sanctions.

<u>Elaine Scattergood</u>, 75 30th Street, asked that the Borough respond accordingly to property owners complaining about noise related to construction activity and suggested that Councilman McCorristin's interest in this process is partial and that Councilman McCorristin should be recusing himself from the discussions of amending the Borough Code regarding such activity. She voiced concerns about the five minute restriction on public comments and asked that Council listen to the concerns of taxpayers rather than watching the clock.
