Scott Wahl: reported immediately following the last Council meeting two weeks ago, Scott, Steve Camp, and Shawn Carr, took a look at the back-passing and beach fill operations on 12th Street. Administration is pleased to report that the Borough has completed the project ahead of schedule and has moved approximately 60,000 cubic yards of sand from the borrow area into the North End. In spite of the challenges this project has faced, Scott commended Public Works and gave a special thanks to Steve Camp and staff for an admirable job.
