Scott Wahl reported he will be attending a pre-construction meeting on September 26, 2019 with Thomas Thornton, Dr. Stewart Farrell, William Macomber in Stone Harbor attending regarding the beach fill project. It is the intent of the Army Corps to award the base contract of approximately 425,000 cubic yards of sand for the Borough of Avalon. Funding from the DEP would pay for approximately an additional 50,000 cubic yards of material, which will bring the total beach fill to approximately 500,000 cubic yards of sand to the beach. This project would eliminate the necessity of a backpassing project for the Borough in 2020. Administration intends to ask when the project will start and what the Borough's options are to add more sand to the project, if needed.
