Reports and Recommendations by Mayor and Officials: Reports of Officials:

Scott Wahl read the following report:

Governor's Executive Order: Details regarding the Governor's new executive order restricting indoor and outdoor gatherings will be detailed later today. Essentially starting at 6:00am Tuesday, all indoor gatherings will be reduced from 25 to ten individuals. Outdoor gatherings will be reduced from 500 to 150 a week from today. This will eliminate indoor activities like Sit and Be Fit at Community Hall and bingo at the Senior Center. This has resulted in some significant changes to our Thanksgiving weekend activities now as concerts, performances, and carriage rides will all be eliminated. There are some select activities that we can continue with upon consent of the Mayor who serves as Director of Public Safety. I'm hopeful within 24 hours we will be able to release what we can continue with that weekend. It appears that indoor dining and indoor retail are not subject to further restrictions.

Borough Hall Roof Project: We have notification on our municipal website regarding the roof replacement project at Borough Hall and the Senior Center. The project is anticipated to begin on November 23rd with mobilization of the contractor and materials. There will be two staging areas, one at a time, which will occupy some spaces in the parking lot in back of the building. Once the Borough Hall roof is replaced, the large staging area disappears and a much smaller staging area is established adjacent to the Senior Center for that project. All work will be done by February, 2021. Employees have been notified about noise disruptions.

County Hazard Mitigation Plan: In addition to Avalon's Floodplain Management Plan, the County is updating its Hazard Mitigation Plan for all-natural disasters in our County. Avalon has been the lead municipality in the plan. We have notices on our website and social media pages inviting participation for comment on the County's plan, which is managed by the Cape May County Department of Emergency Management.

Scott Wahl (continued):

<u>Bulkhead Replacement:</u> The contractor who was awarded the bulkhead replacement project intends to start work before Christmas. The contract, previously approved by Borough Council, will result in bulkhead replacements at 22nd and 26th streets, along with a ten-foot section of bulkhead at 80th Street.

<u>Landscape Contract</u>: The Borough held a pre-bid meeting on the landscape contract on November 13th. The bid opening for the contract will be held December 8th, with potential recommendation to Council for discussion and award at the December 16th Borough Council meeting.

<u>Council President McCorristin</u> wished everyone a Happy Thanksgiving and encouraged all to continue to be safe in these troubling times.
