ORDINANCE NO. 817-2021

AN ORDINANCE TO EXCEED THE MUNICIPAL BUDGET APPROPRIATION LIMITS AND TO  
ESTABLISH A CAP BANK (N.J.S.A. 40A:4-45.14)

The Ordinance pursuant to the Local Government Cap Law, N.J.S. 40A: 4-45.1 et seq., provides that in the preparation of its annual budget, a municipality shall limit any increase in said budget up to 1.0% unless authorized by ordinance to increase it to 3.5% over the previous year's final appropriations and allows banking of unused cap balances from 2019 & 2020 for use in 2021.

This Ordinance was introduced and passed on first reading on February 24, 2021 and will be further considered for second reading, public hearing and final adoption on March 10, 2021 at the Municipal Building, 3100 Dune Drive, Avalon, NJ 08202 at 4:15 p.m.
