Reports of Officials:

Scott Wahl gave the following report:

Ingram's Thorofare Bridge: There will be another day of long daytime delays on the bridge Thursday, and an overnight closure this evening, and again Thursday evening. Cape May County Engineer, Robert Church, has confirmed that this will result in the final concrete pours for the bridge. Later, there will be a final resurfacing of the bridge. The open lane does not have the final driving surface on it.

Borough Hall Roof: The contractor performing the installation of the new roof is in its final days of work. The Senior Center roof was completed on Tuesday. Little work remains, including the remediation of various small leaks that occurred while the roof was being placed on Borough Hall and the Senior Center. The contractor may demobilize completely next week.

Scott Wahl report (continued):

Shore Protection Fund: As Council may be aware, the State Senate is scheduled to vote on an increase in the Shore Protection Fund from \$25 million to \$50 million. This would be the first increase in the fund since 1998; it is financed through realty transfer fees and provides important matching state funding for Army Corps projects. I had a meeting with Senator Testa on Monday and he affirmed that the bill has his full support, along with support from Assemblymen Simonsen and McClellan.

<u>Hydraulic Beach Fill:</u> I have worked with Warwick Consultants for the mayors of Avalon and Stone Harbor to provide a letter to Senators Booker and Menendez, and Congressman Jeff Van Drew, for support for funding for a hydraulic beach fill project in 2022 along the Seven Mile Beach. Next year we should be in line for the hydraulic beach fill project.

AHLOA Budget Presentation: This Saturday, I will be making the AHLOA budget presentation for the Borough. A visual presentation has been prepared by the CFO. The budget as introduced includes no increase in the local purpose tax, no increase in water/sewer fees, and no increase in beach tags, with the elimination of all general long term debt obligation.

<u>Bulkhead Replacement Project:</u> The Borough of Avalon will be replacing two complete bulkheads, and fixing a small section of a third bulkhead in March-April, 2021. The project was authorized by Avalon Borough Council and will be conducted by Channel Marine. The municipal bulkheads at 22nd and 26th streets will be replaced; a small section of the bulkhead at 80th Street will be repaired. Here is the estimated construction schedule provided by the contractor:

22nd Street Bulkhead: Begin work 3/10/21; Estimated completion 3/24/21 26th Street Bulkhead: Begin work 3/31/21; Estimated completion 4/21/21 80th Street Bulkhead: Begin work 4/22/21; Estimated completion 4/28/21

<u>Council President McCorristin</u> reported recent work being done by Comcast in the area and suggested the Borough investigate the work being done to ensure 5G is not being implemented by Comcast, as they have not gone through any of the steps required by Borough Ordinance for 5G implementation.
