Public Comments:

John Ginelli, 2878 Avalon Avenue, indicated he is a concerned individual that sent Borough Council and Mayor Pagliughi correspondence voicing his concerns about the potential transfer of the Jack's Place liquor license to the boardwalk property, and thanked the Borough for the prompt response and explanation of facts surrounding the allegations of this transfer. Mr. Ginelli noted when the correspondence was sent, he had no facts to refer to other than rumors and concerns from neighbors and other property owners. When rumors of the potential liquor license transfer began to circulate, many felt the need to have their voices heard making it evident many property owners are sensitive to changes on the boardwalk. He stated since receiving clarification from the Borough that no applications have been received for any such development or transfer, that news was relayed to concerned neighbors and property owners. He thanked the Borough for the prompt response and explanation of facts surrounding the allegations of this transfer and expressed hope for interactive access to Council Meetings in the future in the event this item appears on a future agenda.
