ORDINANCE NO. 842-2022

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING AND SUPPLEMENTING CHAPTER 2 OF THE AVALON BOROUGH CODE AND ORDINANCE No. 831-2021 PERTAINING TO THE CERTIFICATION REQUIREMENTS FOR THE MUNICIPAL COURT ADMINISTRATOR AND DEPUTY COURT ADMINISTRATOR

This Ordinance amends Chapter 2 of the Borough Code, Section 2-27 (Municipal Court Administrator) as follows:

Section 1: Amends the Borough Code to provide that whenever a vacancy occurs in the office of Municipal Court Administrator or Deputy Court Administrator after May 25, 2011 (5 years after the effective date of P.L. 2006, c. 20) a municipality may appoint an uncertified individual to the positions of Administrator or Deputy Administrator, on an interim basis for one year which can be extended for two additional successive terms of one year each pending the appointee becoming certified.

The amendment maintains the Borough policy that whenever a Department or Division Head is required to be certified, then the Deputy, if there is one, must also be certified either at the time of appointment, or if not required for appointment, then within such time as required by State Law or Borough Ordinance.

Section 2 & 3: Provides that all inconsistent ordinances are repealed and that the provisions are severable.

Section 4: The Ordinance will take effect immediately.

This Ordinance was introduced and passed on first reading on April 27, 2022 and will be further considered for second reading, public hearing and final adoption on May 11, 2022 at the Municipal Building, 3100 Dune Drive, Avalon, NJ 08202 at 4:15 p.m.
