Reports of Officials:

Scott Wahl announced the beach renourishment project will be done hauling sand on the beaches tomorrow, June 9, 2022 with final grading, equipment and material removal taking place thereafter. It is expected that the project will be fully complete no later than Monday, June 13, 2022. He commended Mount Construction for completing a safe project, and Thomas Thornton and Shawn Carr from Mott MacDonald for their exemplary oversight of the project. He informed Council at the June 22, 2022 Council Meeting, presentations will be made by the Atlantic County Joint Insurance Fund (JIF) regarding policy renewal, and by Administration concerning a uniform trash cart system for the Borough. He expressed happiness to report the Borough is now officially out to bid for the trash contract, with a prebid meeting scheduled for June 23, 2022.

William McCormick reported in the fall of 2021, Public Works discovered a sinkhole at the end of 8th Street and the bay, near Windward Harbor, which has gradually increased in size. Upon further inspection, Public Works discovered an extreme unsafe condition. A work plan was designed by Thomas Thornton, and a quote was received from a contractor, which was higher than the bid threshold. After discussion, the Public Works Department volunteered to complete the work. After a two-day construction period, the area has been repaired, graded, and formed. The project will be complete when an outside mason contractor is able to pour the sidewalks in the area and the two sets of removed steps are reinstalled. As of now, the area is safe for the public.

<u>Thomas Thornton</u> commended the Public Works Department for their hard work and dedication to Avalon, which helped save the Borough from a public safety issue and a large expense.

<u>Chief Christopher</u> noted as Council is aware, the Avalon Police Department is accredited through the New Jersey State Association of Chiefs of Police. Recently, an assessment for the fourth year of accreditation took place. Since that assessment, a preliminary determination has indicated that the Avalon Police Department is in 100% compliance in over 130 standards. Receiving a fourth consecutive accreditation puts the Avalon Police Department in an elite class of three percent of the Police Departments in the state of New Jersey. The Commission Hearing is scheduled for next week, with an official determination forthcoming.
