ORDINANCE NO. 843-2022

AN ORDINACE AMENDING CHAPTER 21 OF THE BOROUGH CODE REQUIRING PORTABLE FIRE EXTINGUISHERS IN ALL DWELLING UNITS WITHIN MULTIPLE DWELLING BUILDINGS

This Ordinance amends Chapter 21 of the Borough Code, (Fire Safety) Section 21-1.7 (Inspections) as follows:

Section 1: Amends the Borough Code to provide that a portable fire extinguisher meeting certain minimum requirements shall be required in each unit within a multiple dwelling when such unit contains cooking facilities of any type; regulating the installation and placement thereof; addressing fire extinguishers in hotel and motel units, and providing for alternate installations which are approved by the Fire Official.

Section 2 & 3: Provides that all inconsistent ordinances are repealed and that the provisions are severable.

Section 4: The Ordinance will take effect immediately upon adoption on May 25, 2022 with enforcement effective July 1, 2022.

This Ordinance was introduced and passed on first reading on May 11, 2022 and will be further considered for second reading, public hearing and final adoption on May 25, 2022 at the Municipal Building, 3100 Dune Drive, Avalon, NJ 08202 at 4:15 p.m.
