Reports and Recommendations by Mayor and Officials: Reports of Officials:

Scott Wahl read the following report:

<u>CRS Program:</u> Avalon received confirmation on Thursday, May 4th that the Borough's 2022 CRS program verification cycle is complete. We are pleased to report to Council that the report verifies that Avalon will maintain a Class 3 rating in the CRS program which provides 35% discounts on flood insurance to property owners who have this insurance. Our next step is a full annual recertification that will begin in September and conclude in October. As Council is aware, the verification and reporting requirements once you hit a Class 3 are more strenuous. Avalon continues to work towards a Class 2.

Beach Fill: Councilman McDermott and I attended the beach fill meeting which has now been moved to Stone Harbor because the Avalon fill is complete. Our interest was news presented one week ago today that there will be very minor work in front of the hotels between 78-80th streets to taper in to the Stone Harbor fill which begins on 80th Street and works north to south. The anticipated start would be Memorial Day weekend. There have been challenging weather conditions due to persistent northeasterly winds of completing the demobilization from Avalon as subline remains in the water, and the dredge remains in Cape May Harbor. Now we are hearing that the anticipated start date will be Tuesday, May 30th. The total sand volume on the Avalon beach is 580,768. Work remaining includes post and rail fence on the 20th Street crossover and dune grass planting which will occur in the fall. Earlier today, the plan was to knock down the scarp along the beach that forms naturally when the ocean approaches the new sand on the beach.

<u>Paul Short</u> announced starting Friday, May 26, 2023, the access road between the Fire Department and the Municipal Building will be accessible. Fencing around the construction area at the Fire Department will also be removed, freeing up the parking spaces currently obstructed by the fence. Starting Tuesday, May 30, 2023, portions of the parking lot and access road will again be inaccessible when the ongoing construction at the Fire Department resumes.
